



Committee Meeting Minutes
Monday, April 4, 2016

Present: Fred Capron, Scott Lobdell, Ceil Hunt, and Herb Durfee

Fred called the meeting to order at 9:00AM. We welcomed Herb Durfee and shared with him our desire to thank committee members during Volunteer Week. This would be done through an ad in the Rutland Herald. It was decided that the town and Concerts Committee would share the cost of the ad and thank ALL those who volunteer for the town of Fair Haven. Ceil, Scott and Herb will create the text. Lighting in the park was the next topic of discussion. The first step is to get an engineering report to determine where the lights should be installed. Before commissioning the report, the committee will make a presentation to the Board of Selectmen. Our main goal is to make the park a safer space for citizens. Lighting in the park is especially needed as the daylight wanes earlier during the last few concerts. Herb believes that we should be able to make the agenda for the May 10th meeting.

We discussed sound at the concerts. Scott continues to try and contact Atomic Sound. We will be contacting our two sound folks to see if they wish to continue working sound for the concerts. We will only need sound for 9 concerts as the Army Band will bring all their own equipment. In addition, we will not be giving out door prizes during this concert.

Fair Haven Concerned asked if they might sponsor an ice cream night. They will be bringing the ice cream on June 30, 2016. We want to make the ice cream nights special, so this will be a one-time event.

Ceil will write a Letter to the Editor of the Rutland Herald about the upcoming concert series.
