

RESOLUTION – TOWN OF FAIR HAVEN

AUTHORIZING A RECYCLING ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE TOWN OF FAIR HAVEN, VERMONT

WHEREAS, It has been determined by the Town of Fair Haven that it is in the best interest of our citizens to continue recycling efforts in the most efficient, effective and optimal manner possible; and

WHEREAS, The Town understands its responsibility to make every effort possible to preserve our environment, protect our natural resources and provide a safe place for our citizens to work and play; and


WHEREAS, the Town acknowledges the importance of obtaining community participation in determining what efforts the Town will make towards recycling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Selectboard of the Town of Fair Haven, Vermont, that:

1. A Recycling Advisory Committee be formed consisting of 3-5 people acting in a voluntary capacity.
2. The Committee members will be appointed by the Selectboard, with consensus of the Town Manager.
 - The committee chairperson will be chosen by the Committee members at their initial meeting. The chairperson will also serve as a liaison between the Selectboard, Town Manager, and the Public.
3. The Committee will advise the Selectboard and Town Manager on all aspects of recycling, including but not limited to:
 - A. evaluating and enhancing recycling operations;
 - B. developing and implementing promotional and educational programs;
 - C. serving as a source for ideas, new concepts, suggestions and innovations in the field of recycling;






