April 1, 2015

Motion made and seconded to accept the minutes of the last meeting.

The treasurer's report was discussed. It was agreed to plan to open the safe deposit box at the bank and evaluate contents and continued use. There was a motion made and seconded to accept the treasurer's report with one correction noted.

Carol Scott presented the librarian's report for March. The Irish music program was a success with 63 people in attendance.

Story time was discussed and it was agreed to look into changing the schedule of this activity when required preschool attendance begins in Vermont. We may want to coordinate closely with early ed and preschool programs.

Total circulation for the month of May was the second highest one month total in eight years. While state officials report that circulation is decreasing in some libraries around the state, our library continues to be very active. Wireless use is also very high.

Work has been going on in the non-fiction room with over 100 old biographies being culled. The result is a much more user-friendly non-fiction area of the library. There were over 70 volunteer hours in March devoted to the automation project and it is going well.

Carol will attend the Rutland County Librarians Meeting on April 2.

The next meeting of the library board will be on Wednesday, May 6, 2015 at 7 pm at the library.
